PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Dear Hilltop Families,

We are a week into 2021, and the continued dedication of our staff is evident once again. Our teachers are creating lessons, routines and assignments that intentionally meet the key standards for their grade level while responding to current events and the social-emotional needs of their students. They are doing this in partnership with all you, and your contribution to your child's education this year is a critical component. We are thankful for your efforts, and your continued support of our teachers.

This last month has brought news of vaccinations and changes in the recommendations of when schools can offer in-person learning. More details will be communicated in the coming weeks from the district about when we will be offering a hybrid model for younger grades. The district has heard the feedback that families need more explicit details about what the hybrid (in-person + asynchronous) model will look like. We understand that families might need to change the learning model they selected for their children in the fall, and there will be a process to gather this information.

Our Developmental Kindergarten students started in-person on January 4th, so we already have 10 students on campus learning in-person. Please share with your older students and neighbors that the entire campus is closed from 8AM-4PM on school days to protect our in-person students. Of course, you may still come to the office door when needed.

We are continuing to find ways to build CONNECTIONS at Hilltop. If your child needs a chance for some informal time with peers on Zoom, have them join Wednesday recess. Students choose a breakout room to attend based on their interests, and there is a recess monitor in each room. Counselors are offering other opportunities for Kindergarten (lunch bunches) and 6th Grade (art sessions.)




Martin Luther King JR. Virtual Assembly

"Choose to Move 60!" fall session will wrap up on January 29, 2021. We had over 1,700 students enrolled in the fall session which was awesome! We know that students that participate in exercise, physical activity, and movement focus better in school, sleep better, feel healthier, and have lower rates of depression.
