Dear Families,

As we finish strong with our last three weeks of school, we are celebrating how far our students have come this year. I am so proud of our staff, students and families for how student learning was prioritized across the school year. This month, teachers are meeting with the next grade level to share areas of class strengths and needs as a result of this school year.

When we started the year in September, we didn't know what the impact of the pandemic would have on students. We now know that students that maintained solid attendance made typical progress, in a not-so-typical year. We are so happy that we were able to prioritize getting library books, digital books and classroom take-home books to support our readers at home. And, truly, we are thankful that parents helped to keep students reading.

We've also noticed some areas that we will focus on with students next year. We learned that writing is challenging to teach online, and we are cherishing the moments that teachers get to confer with each student to teach that one strategy that the writer is ready for. Teachers have delved deep into discussions about how to approach real life math problems, and we love the thinking and solving our students continue to do. However, we have been reminded that students need lots of practice putting together and taking apart numbers, and developing strategies to remember math facts.

We continue to support social-emotional learning, and we have enjoyed watching how classmates have progressed from being timid with each other to becoming more sibling-like in just a couple of months of a hybrid model. We know that some of our older students are working with challenging feelings related to the last twelve months. If your child is struggling emotionally or socially, please reach out to one of our counselors or your child's teacher so we can use these last few weeks of school to help strengthen connections with peers and suggest strategies for dealing with big emotions.

We are celebrating and being aware of what our students need all at the same time! Overall, we are feeling ready to tackle the next school year with the same sense of vigor, and a little bit more normalcy than this year.

We hope you are planning to relax and enjoy this summer. Take time to read together, talk a lot, count forward and backwards, play card games, and be creative!

Message from the School Nurse:

It is time to wrap up this year AND get ready for the next school year! If your student has medications or a health plan, you should have received the paperwork needed for next year already. If you haven't, please contact me and I will get it to you!

Most medications can be sent home with parent authorization. They will be secured in a security bag. I must receive your authorization to send them home with your student on their last school day, those letters have also been sent home. The last day is June 22nd for Cohort B and June 24th for Cohort A. Medications cannot be stored at the school over the summer. All medications not picked up will be disposed of on the morning of June 25th.

Note that medications for next year must be received at the school by August 24th in order for your student to start on the first day. If received after that date, there is not guarantee your student will start on time.


