- Reading before the official beginning of the Read-A-Thon does ***not*** count
- Reading during class does ***not*** count
- Being read to by other people counts so long as it isn't during school
- Reading aloud to a pet counts
- Homework reading counts so long as it is done before or after school
- Reading aloud to other people counts, even over zoom! If you happen to read to someone who is also participating in the Read-A-Thon, it counts for ***both*** of you!
